Players handicaps may change during the championships and they must play off correct handicap each round, however players will not change grades during the competition.

Ties in the gross section of each grade will be decided by an 18 hole play off at a date and time designated by the Match Committee.

Ties in the nett section of each grade will be decided on a countback on the final round

The top 3 players in each grade after the second round will play the final round together at a time designated by the Match Committee.

To be eligible to play in the Club Championship a minimum of six rounds of Emerald Golf Club competition must be played per annum, this does not include the rounds of the Club Championship

Serviceman's Day
