ETIQUETTE OF THE GAME OF GOLF

All competitions are to be played under the Rules Of Golf in conjunction with the Local Rules on the scorecard and any other Temporary Local Rules.

Players should enter names in competition book and pay entry fee prior to playing.
Players should check current handicaps.

Players should always check for any Local Rules or Notices.

No-one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.

No player should play until the group ahead is out of range.
All players should play without delay.

ETIQUETTE continued

All players are expected to carry sand buckets with sand. Players should repair and fill divots and repair pitch marks on the green.

After having played out of a bunker, the player should rake the holes and footmarks made therein.

If a stray shot is played, nominate and play a provisional ball.

If a ball cannot readily be found, call the following group through.

Buggies should be parked to the side and not in front of greens.

When a hole is completed players should immediately leave the putting green.

Do not mark scorecards on the green.

After completing a round scorecards should be checked, signed and returned as soon as possible.

REMEMBER

Your place on the golf course is immediately behind the group in front, not in front of the group behind.

The top 3 players in each grade after the second round will play the final round together at a time designated by the Match Committee.

Daily Markers – Played in pairs where player 1 scores 2 points & player 2 has 3 points you multiply $3 \times 2 = 6$ points for the hole .

All competitions are under the control of the Match Committee who may change, alter, postpone or vary the rules or date of play at their discretion. Any protest in connection with any match or competition must be lodged with the Match Committee immediately upon the completion of such match or competition. Any such protest shall be dealt with as early as possible by the Match Committee whose decision shall be final.

*I hope these golf tips will make your
golf more enjoyable.*

Have a few hits in the net, before you play plus 10 minutes on the putting green, just to get a feel of your game.

Start with the short shots and then work through the irons to the driver. Most golfers have not picked up a club since the previous Saturday, so check your grip, stance, alignment etc.

Tension comes from holding the club to tight , The hands are the only part of your body touching the club so try to relax them. Soft hands are most important. At the address another person should be able to pull the club through your hands, while you are holding it. This will make your swing more co-ordinated and smooth, as the muscles will be more relaxed.

Swinging your arms quickly won't make the ball go further the power and distance comes from good timing and club head speed in the hitting area.

Short shots: Use your shoulders and cock your wrists slightly on the back-swing, but requires firm wrists on the follow through, this will create more backswing.

Chipping and putting is much the same, the length of the swing controls the distance, not the speed. The longer the distance, the longer you swing, always try and make your Follow through the same or longer.
